

TIMOTHY E. SHEAFF IHSSA Hall of Fame 2022 IN MEMORIUM

We are saddened by the passing of IHSSA Hall of Fame Member and the voice of the NSDA National awards emceee Timothy E. Sheaff. Tim was a legendary debate/drama/speech director at Dowling Catholic High School in West Des Moines, whose over 30-year-long career competitive success was felt locally and at the national level. His devoted service to the speech and debate communities was continually generous and filled with an abundance of joy. Tim served on the IHSSA Debate Committee, as well the NSDA Board of Directors. Tim also prided himself on mentoring countless new coaches during his tenure. Tim's service to the community shined most as emcee for the final rounds and awards ceremonies for nearly 20 years at the National Tournament. During that time, he introduced more than 2200 judges and celebrated the accomplishments of almost 5000 individual student competitors. For Tim, speech and debate was a family affair. His six children were highly successful speech and debate competitors. Tim's voice, his mentorship, and his leadership will be greatly missed.
